The City of Irvine has been divided into six districts and separated out for the reasons listed below.

**REASONING BEHIND DISTRICT ONE (ORANGE)** is that these are newer homes with a population that is growing. These residents have a direct interest in what is constructed at the Great Park. The tip of Lower Peters Canyon is factored in as a neighboring community to Orchard Hills.

**REASONING BEHIND DISTRICT TWO (PURPLE)** is the ability to keep Northwood and Northwood Point together and incorporating its neighboring community of Lower Peters Canyon.

**REASONING BEHIND DISTRICT THREE (YELLOW)** is that it allows Westpark and Westpark II to remain in one district. It incorporates a diverse mix with Walnut and El Camino Real.

**REASONING BEHIND DISTRICT FOUR (GREEN)** is these villages are largely townhomes and owner occupied. The south corner of El Camino Real was incorporated in as a neighboring community with like affiliations.

**REASONING BEHIND DISTRICT FIVE (BLUE)** is the largest population in these communities are also the first communities that were built in Irvine. Largely single family, or townhomes that are owner occupied, the communities of Woodbridge and Turtle Rock are populated with long time residents.

**REASONING BEHIND DISTRICT SIX (PINK)** in a seemingly world of their own, these villages are centered around the Irvine University where residents are not considered to be long term and with the majority population being renters.
