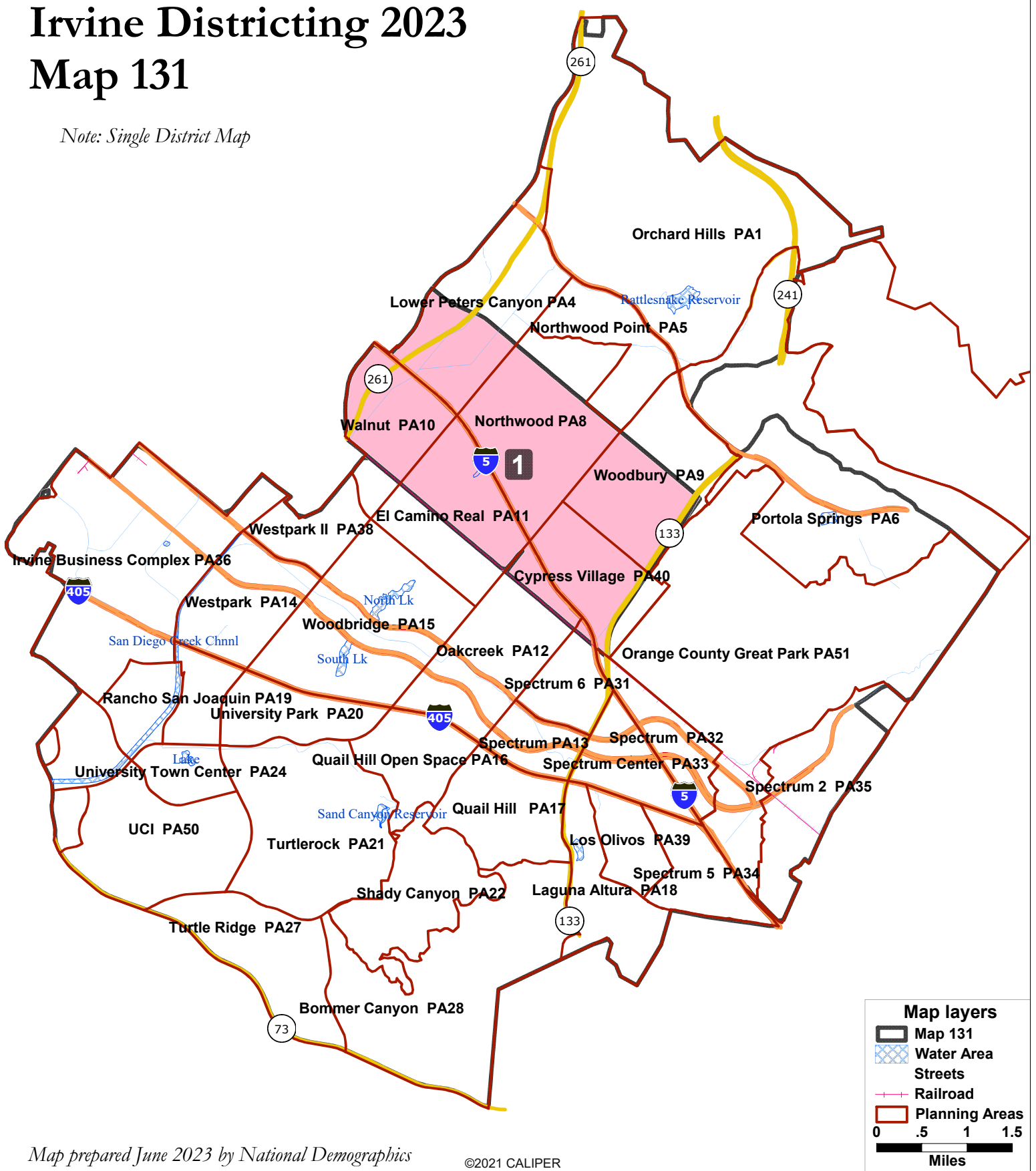


Irvine Districting 2023
