

PROVIDE INPUT ON A DISTRICT MAP FOR THE MARCH 2024 BALLOT

The City of Irvine's pursuit of district elections is still underway!

Public Hearing — October 10 at 6 p.m.

At the fourth districting public hearing held on September 12, the Irvine City Council continued its discussion on proposed draft maps and narrowed them down to three focus maps for further consideration at the fifth public hearing on October 10.



The City's demographer also created two additional maps based on feedback provided by the Irvine City Council at the public hearing held on September 12.



At the public hearing on October 10, the City Council will revisit the focus maps, review any additional maps submitted by the September 29 deadline, and ultimately choose one map to be placed on the March 2024 ballot for voters' consideration.
